



FOOD IMPORT REQUIREMENTS



INTRODUCTION

In terms of food safety, foods and food contact materials imported shall abide to the Food Act 1983 and its regulations pertaining to the safety, standards and labeling requirements under the purview of the Food Safety and Quality Division (FSQD), Ministry of Health (MOH). Inspections of foods are conducted at each entry point throughout the country whereby its approvals and clearances are fully conducted online via the Food Safety Information System of Malaysia (FoSIM), a web-based system interfaced with the Customs Information System (CIS).

OBJECTIVE

- To ensure participants aware of the requirements for food imported into Malaysia in terms of food safety and food biosecurity;
- To ensure participants aware of the Customs (Prohibition of Imports) Order 2017 and how to conduct an import declaration through CIS;
- To ensure participants are aware of the FoSIM system to clear food consignments from the entry point.

- ❑ Introduction to the Customs (Prohibition of Imports) Order 2017 and how to conduct an import declaration through CIS;
