<p>Bagi tujuan pengeksporthan produk telur dan hasilan telur serta produk hasilan susu ke Taiwan, pengeksporthan yang terlibat perlu memastikan keperluan negara pengimport adalah dipatuhi.</p> <p>Pihak <i>Food and Drug Administration (FDA), Ministry of Health and Welfare</i>, Taiwan telah mengenakan keperluan baru untuk pengeksporthan telur dan hasilan telur (HS Codes 0407, 0408 dan 3502) serta produk susu dan hasilan susu tertentu (HS Codes 0401, 040210, 0403, 0404, 040520, 040610, 040630 dan 040640) ke Taiwan. Pada masa ini, pengeksporthan produk-produk tersebut perlu mendapat kelulusan daripada FDA, Taiwan.</p> <p>Sekiranya ingin mengeksporth produk-produk tersebut ke Taiwan, pihak pengeksporth perlu menghantar permohonan secara bertulis ke Bahagian ini bagi tujuan kelulusan oleh pihak FDA, Taiwan.</p> <p>Selain itu, pengeksporthan produk telur dan hasilan telur serta susu dan hasilan susu juga perlu mematuhi keperluan kuarantin daripada <i>Council of Agriculture</i>, Taiwan.</p> <p>Disertakan adalah senarai butiran HS Codes (Lampiran 1) dan <i>Regulations for Systematic Inspection of Imported Food</i> daripada FDA, Taiwan (Lampiran 2)</p> <p>Sebarang pertanyaan lanjut, sila hubungi Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri/ Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah yang berhampiran.</p>

Telur dan Hasil Telur	
0407	Birds' eggs, in shell, fresh, preserved or cooked.
0408	Birds' eggs, not in shell, and egg yolks, fresh, dried, cooked by steaming or by boiling in water, moulded, frozen or otherwise preserved, whether or not containing added sugar or other sweetening matter.
3502	Albumins (including concentrates of two or more whey proteins, containing by weight more than 80 % whey proteins, calculated on the dry matter), albuminates and other albumin derivatives.
Susu dan Hasil Susu	
0401	Milk and cream, not concentrated nor containing added sugar or other sweetening matter.
040210	Milk and cream, concentrated or containing added sugar or other sweetening matter. - In powder, granules or other solid forms, of a fat content, by weight, not exceeding 1.5 %
0403	Buttermilk, curdled milk and cream, yogurt, kephir and other fermented or acidified milk and cream, whether or not concentrated or containing added sugar or other sweetening matter or flavoured or containing added fruit, nuts or cocoa.
0404	Whey, whether or not concentrated or containing added sugar or other sweetening matter; products consisting of natural milk constituents, whether or not containing added sugar or other sweetening matter, not elsewhere specified or included.
040520	Dairy spreads
040610	Fresh (unripened or uncured) cheese, including whey cheese, and curd
040630	Processed cheese, not grated or powdered
040640	Blue-veined cheese and other cheese containing veins produced by <i>Penicillium roqueforti</i>

LAMPIRAN 2

Regulations for Systematic Inspection of Imported Food

Promulgated on February 11, 2014

Amended on October 17, 2014

Amended on August 4, 2017

Amended on September 17, 2018

Article 1 These Regulations are established in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 2 of Article 35 of the Act Governing Food Safety and Sanitation (hereinafter referred to as "Act").

Article 2 The terms used in these Regulations are defined as follows:

1. "Systematic inspection" means inspecting the food safety management system and the supervisory measures taken by the governments of the exporting country (territory).
2. "Inspection authority" means the Food and Drug Administration, Ministry of Health and Welfare.
3. "Document review" means reviewing the documentation relating to the food safety management system in the exporting country (territory) provided by the governmental authority of the exporting country (territory).
4. "On-site inspection" means the inspection authority designates inspectors to conduct the systematic inspection of the food safety management system in the exporting country (territory).

Article 3 The scope of products subject to systematic inspection is outlined in the attachment.

Article 4 To perform systematic inspection, the exporting country (territory) shall apply to the Inspection authority for approval of import of the product described in the above paragraph. Inspection authority shall conduct the document review. If required, on-site inspection can be conducted following the document review. Only if the food safety management system of the exporting country (territory) is determined as equivalent based on the systematic inspection, the application of the exporting country (territory) will be approved. If necessary, Inspection authority shall request the exporting country (territory) to provide the documents within the designated period when performing the pre-said document review.

Products which are subject to the scope of this regulation, are not conforming to the paragraph 1 of this Article shall not be applied for inspection unless are exempt according to Article 7.

Article 5 For any exporting country (territory) that has been systematically inspected and been approved to import or that is exempted from systematic inspection in accordance with the provisions of Article 7, in case of any of the following, the inspection authority may request document review or on-site inspection to confirm the equivalence of the management system of the exporting country (territory).

1. Significant changes of food safety management system or the supervisory measures of the exporting country (territory).

2. Occurrence of significant food sanitation and safety incidents in the exporting country (territory).
3. Significant violation of the food or related product from the exporting country (territory) found by the inspection authority or other importing country (territory).
4. Any exporting country (territory) that is exempted from systematic inspection in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 or that has been finished systematically inspected more than three years, deemed necessary to conduct documents review or on-site inspection by the inspection authority.
5. Food or related products which from the exporting country (territory) were determined as jeopardizing food safety.

Article 6 If the results of on-site inspection are non-compliant, the exporting country (territory) may be required to submit corrective actions, to the inspection authority for review before deadline. If required, on-site inspection might be performed again to verify the effectiveness of the corrective actions and on-site inspection cost shall be borne by the exporting country (territory).

Article 7 Products, subjected to the scope of this regulation, had existed import records before promulgation of these Regulation might be exempted from the systematic inspection.

Article 8 These Regulations are implemented from the date of publication.

Products on the left column subject to importation rules F01 or F02. 2. These products come into enforcement from January 1, 2018.
Egg Products	Products listed in 0407, 0408 and 3502 of the Harmonized System Codes (HS Codes) established by the World Customs Organization.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Products on the left column subject to importation rules B01 and F01. 2. These products come into enforcement from January 1, 2019.

Animal Oil Products	Products listed in 15 of the Harmonized System Codes (HS Codes) established by the World Customs Organization.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Products on the left column subject to importation rules B01 and included F01. 2. These products come into enforcement from January 1, 2019.
Products of bovine origin	Bovine derivatives food products, not classified as meat products, from BSE infected countries.	<p>Products on the left column belong to following foods are exempted:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Tallow and its derivatives without protein; (2) Calcium hydrogen phosphate without protein; (3) Bovine hide; (4) Gelatin and collagen from bovine hide; (5) Bovine derived products from non-BSE-infected countries or the BSE infected-country has been completed the systematic inspection with certificate of origin of the material and sanitation (health) certificate of the product.
